Dates: Tuesday, June 1st – Thursday, July 1st

Fees: Tuition will be funded by a grant this year! ☺

* You will have your choice of completing your Summer School course(s) at home or in-person at your campus. There will be teachers available for help on each campus and students will be provided a breakfast and lunch. Transportation provided with grant funding for all students within school boundaries (transit-style stops).

* All students will have access to their Edgenuity or Schools PLP class(es) 24/7.

* All coursework taken online or at the BUHSD Learning Center, EFHS, or YHS must be completed by 12 pm (noon) on July 1st. Students attending in-person at these sites will be released to go home at noon. Students attending in-person at BUHS must be completed by 1 pm on July 1st and will be released to go home at that time.

Classes Offered

Various classes are offered during Summer School. Refer to the attached list on page 4 for complete course listings. You may begin by enrolling in one full (1.0) credit course or two half (0.5) credit courses. If you are a senior only needing one-half (.5) credit to graduate, you are only required to take what is needed to earn a diploma. If you complete your class(es) early, you may enroll in another course if time allows. A maximum of 2.0 credits can be earned in Summer School. Contact the Summer School Counselor if you wish to discuss enrolling in an extra course once completing your initial one(s).

Students have the option between two different programs to take their course(s): courses taken on Edgenuity will be given a letter grade. This platform is best used for Acceleration courses to get ahead, Repeating a class for a better grade, or Credit Deficiency courses for a letter grade. The other program is Schools PLP; these classes will be graded as Pass/Fail. This program is best used for Credit Deficiency or Credit Recovery (classes you have previously taken but failed).

Policies, Procedures, and Expectations

BUHSD Summer School Policies, Procedures, and Expectations are located on page 3 of this packet. By submitting the Google Form, you acknowledge you have read and understand the information. If the in-person option is chosen, students will be expected to attend every day until the course(s) are completed.

School Rules and Expectations

All of the school/district rules and expectations from the regular school year will be enforced during Summer School. These are listed in the Parent-Student Handbook, which can be found on the district's website (www.buhsd.org) under the Parent dropdown link. If an in-person student receives 3 minor discipline referrals, they will be withdrawn from Summer School or sent home to complete their course(s) for the remainder of Summer School.

Registration Process

Complete the appropriate Google Form posted online using the URL provided on the last page of this application or by clicking on the Summer School logo on the district website (www.buhsd.org).

The Google Form must be completed no later than **3 pm on May 21st** if you wish to start classes on Tuesday, June 1st. Applications will be accepted up until 12 pm (noon) on May 28th, but the start of the course may be delayed.

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Policies, Procedures, and Expectations

1. **Grades:**

- Students will receive a letter grade for successful completion of classes on Edgenuity. The grade(s) will figure into a student's GPA and count toward class ranking. These should mainly be classes taken for Acceleration or Repeated to improve a prior grade.
- Students will receive a Pass/Fail for successful completion of classes on Schools PLP. These should mainly be classes taken for Credit Recovery (if you have previously taken a course and failed it) and Credit Deficiency classes. The grade(s) will not be figured into a student's GPA or class ranking.
- Final grades will be provided by teachers/course facilitators upon successful completion of the course(s). All courses must be completed by 12 pm (noon) on July 1st, except for BUHS 1 pm.
- Final grades will be emailed to campus registrars and counselors at the end of the summer term.
- Any course(s) a student earns credit for will be posted to the student's official transcript with the letter grade or pass.
- Grades will be mailed home at the conclusion of Summer School.

2. **Course Completions:** If you complete your class(es) early, contact Ms. Fox, (sfox@buhسد.org) the Summer School Director, for notification. If you would like to start another course, contact Mrs. Lees (mlees@buhسد.org).

3. **Cheating/Plagiarism:** Cheating or plagiarism of any kind is prohibited, and any student found cheating/plagiarizing will be subject to disciplinary action and will receive a zero on the assignment/project/assessment. Student work may be submitted to Turnitin.com to verify originality. District Governing Board Policy will be followed for the violation of this infraction.

4. **Program Specifications:** Summer School courses are taught at a more accelerated pace than the regular school year. With IEPs and 504 plans, universal accommodations may apply during Summer School; however, not all accommodations and modifications on specific student plans may be applicable.

5. **Laptop Procedures:** Students need to follow campus instructions on turning in their laptop if taking a Summer School course.

6. **Attendance Procedures:** Students who choose to take their course in person are required to attend class on their campus every day of Summer School until you complete your class(es) or until the final day of the session (July 1st). Students will be withdrawn from their Summer School class(es) if they miss 3 days of school, unless absences are due to Covid-like illness. In that case, students will be able to continue working on their class(es) from home for the remainder of Summer School.

7. **Covid-19 Mitigation Strategies & Health Information:** All current mitigation strategies being followed on campuses (including cloth face coverings) will be continued during Summer School. Parents please be sure your student's CareDox information is current online. If you have not completed the registration process, please do so before enrolling for Summer School.
