Mask Policy	SUSD schools require all athletes and guests to wear face masks while attending indoor events unless participating in athletic activities.
Team Bus Parking	The team bus should enter through the Oak St. student parking lot between the tennis courts and football stadium.
Locker Facilities	Security will escort you and your teams to your respective locker rooms.
Water	We will provide one/two 10-gallon jugs full of water. Please bring your own bottles to fill. Injury ice will also be provided on the sideline for ATC.
